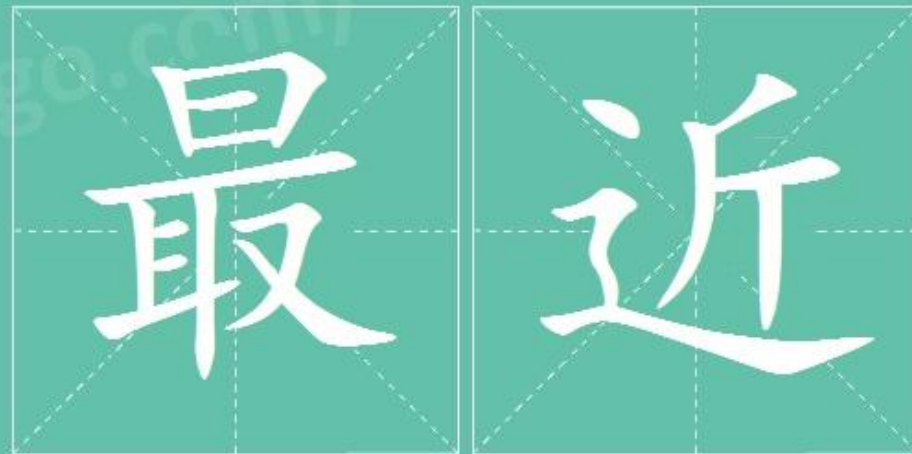

Nǐ hǎo。

你好。

**Hello.**

Common greeting, usually used in strangers who meet first time.

Nǐ hǎo ma?

你好吗?

**How are you?** Usually used in strangers who meet first time or friends who don't meet each other for a long time.

Hǎo jiǔ bú jiàn。

好久不见。

**Long time no see you.**

Used in old friends who don't meet each other for a long time.

Zuì jìn zěn me yàng?

最近怎么样?

**How are you?/How is going on recently.**

Usually used in old friends daily, spoken language.
