

Rules of Pinyin (拼音规则)

1. Pronunciation of Reduplicated Syllables :

- In a disyllabic word with reduplicated syllables, the second syllable is read in the neutral tone.

bàba māma

gēge jiějie

yéye nǎinai

zǒuzou zuòzuo

gūgu shūshu

xièxie kànkàn

tàitai xīngxing

shuōshuo chángchang

Rules of Pīnyīn (拼音规则)

2. Pronunciation of Words with the Suffixs “-们” , “-子” , “-头” :

- Being part of a word, the suffixs “们” , “子” , “头” are read in the neutral tone.

nǐ men	wǒ men

Chinese Radicals:


- “日” (called 日字旁)




