











Wǒ shàng wù gāng jiè le nà běn shūo

我上午刚借了那本书。

I just borrowed that book in the morning.

Wǒ gāng chī le wù fàn $_{\circ}$

我刚吃了午饭。

I just had lunch.

Tā gāng lái xué xiào。

他刚来学校。

He just came to school.
